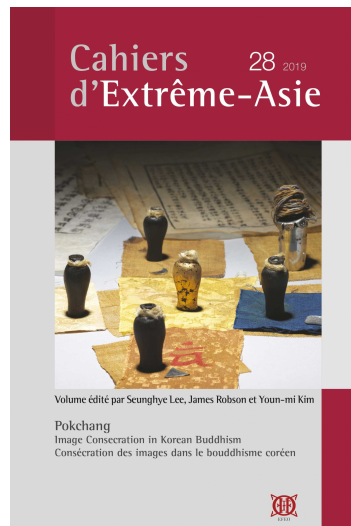

He is the author of *Power of Place: The Religious Landscape of the Southern Sacred Peak [Nanyue in Medieval China* (Harvard University Press, 2009). He has mostly been engaged in a long-term collaborative research project with Alain Arrault of the Ecole française d'Extrême-Orient studying the local religious history of Hunan province, including a large body of small wooden statues and their contents.
